Bachelor of Arts and Bachelor of Laws at Asian Law College is a five year full time degree course affiliated to Ch. Charan Singh University (CCS) Meerut. This is designed and structured to provide the young minds with an intellectual stimulating environment. The course is designed to give students the basic understanding of the legal concepts and its applications. The objective of BA.LL.B. at ALC is to produce excellent professionals who can translate theory into practise and are capable of identifying and solving complex legal problems at national and international levels. The approach towards teaching is more practical where knowledge is imparted alongwith practical application. This Under graduate program equips the students with an indepth understanding of legal theory coupled with intensive industry exposure. The course curriculum is designed after in-depth study of the requirements of all stakeholders and the ever changing demands of the legal industry. The salient features of the program is the emphasis on enhancing the students' soft skills and maximizing the professional interface through varied initiatives. The program also offers tremendous flexibility and learning opportunities through a semester-based approach. At ALC, a student can study the Bachelor of Arts and Bachelor of Laws program and develop understanding about all

the major areas of law like Civil, criminal, Arbitration, competition, Intellectual property, Company law etc. The curriculum is flexible and includes lectures, case-studies, role plays and integrative exercises. The focus of teaching in BA.LL.B. is to build the ability to solve complex legal problems associated with governance of society and nation.



Dr. MOHD. KHALID, PROFESSOR





Dr. WASEEM YUSUF MAKAI



AKSHAY KUMAR




To provide a focal point in the institution to coordinate R&D activities between faculty members, industry and students


National Law University, Ranchi to have established the Centre in India.

11. CORPORATE FIRMS


