LL.M. IN NALSAR



The LL.M course offered by the National Academy of Legal Studies and Research (NALSAR University) and Indian Institute of Corporate Affairs (IICA) is a first of its kind LL.M. Degree program in Insolvency and Bankruptcy Laws and Procedures Law in India. India has a huge, emerging sector for helping distressed and bankrupt companies come out of financial difficulty. But it faces a huge shortage of bankruptcy professionals who can oversee the process. The number of Insolvency Professionals and Insolvency Associates is very less considering the number of filings taking place every day at NCLT. Therefore, there is a serious need to produce good insolvency associates and ecosystem for providing the support to IPs, IPA, Consultancies, Law Firms, ARCs and Academia. Therefore, the Master level course / orientation in Insolvency and Bankruptcy Laws is the need of the hour. There is a vacuum in this area in the legal educational system in the country and this course seeks to fill up this vacuum.



LIFE IN NALSAR

HALLS OF RESIDENCE

The University maintains separate residences for Boys and Girls with a common Dining Hall. The students are provided with double occupancy rooms. The Halls of Residence have common room facilities, Indoor Games, Television, Telephone (only for incoming calls) and Internet Connectivity. The Halls of Residence are connected with Diesel generators. The common mess serves Vegetarian food, however Non-Vegetarian food is also served on students' demand. Management and maintenance of discipline in the Halls of Residence is the responsibility of Students, Proctor, Chief Warden, Wardens and Assistant Wardens. Conforming to the Regulations framed in this regard is mandatory.

GAMES AND SPORTS

A Stadium has been constructed and is equipped with state-of-the-art facilities. Two Tennis Courts one each for Boys and Girls were constructed. Play fields for various sports are under construction. A Gymnasium and Swimming Pool are in the pipeline.

ALLOTMENT OF ROOMS

The Chief Warden/Warden of the respective hostel shall make the allotment of rooms to the applicants. No student shall change the allotted room or occupy a room other than the allotted one without written authorization. Students with chronic medical problems including addiction to smoking, alcoholism and drugs shall not be admitted to the Hostel or allowed to continue their stay.

TRANSPORT

Students are not allowed to bring in or to keep any power-driven two wheeler/four wheeler vehicles in the Hostel/University premises. Taxis and private vehicles shall not be allowed beyond NALSAR Main Gate without written permission of Chief Wardens/Proctor / Registrar.



ABOUT INDIAN INSTITUTE OF CORPORATE AFFAIRS

The campus, spread over 14 acres, comprises Administrative Building, Retreat Block, Director's Residence, Trainees, Hostel comprising 72 rooms and residential complex consisting of 1-BHK and 2 BHK apartments. Trainees are provided twin-sharing accommodation with modern amenities, access to high-speed Wi-Fi and mess serving vegetarian and non-vegetarian cuisines in an elegant dining hall. The morning starts with the sound of chirping birds and the serenity of a green campus. Morning yoga by a professional trainer is a part of the daily routine integrating health for a balanced life. A fully functional gymnasium with all modern and essential fitness and training equipment is accessible to students 24X7. Sports facilities cover a variety of games including football, cricket, badminton, volleyball, billiards and table tennis. High-end boardrooms and modern classrooms are used for delivery of lectures, experts talks and panel discussions.

INFRASTRUCTURE

The Indian Institute of Corporate Affairs is spread over an area of fourteen acres. The Infrastructure comprises Administrative Building, Retreat Block, Director's Residence, Trainees Hostel comprising seventy two rooms and residential complex consisting of 52 one BHK rooms, 10 two BHK rooms and 10 three BHK rooms. All the buildings are maintained by the administrative section of the IICA. Administration Branch is headed by a CAO who is assisted by the Administrative Officers.

TRANSPORT

The campus is well connected to National Highway 8 by Haryana and Rajasthan State Road Transport. Auto Rickshaws and city buses ply from campus area to places like MG Road, Rajiv Chowk and Gurugram area. Services like Ola and Uber are available from Airport, Railway Stations and Metro Stations to facilitate the arrival at the Institute.



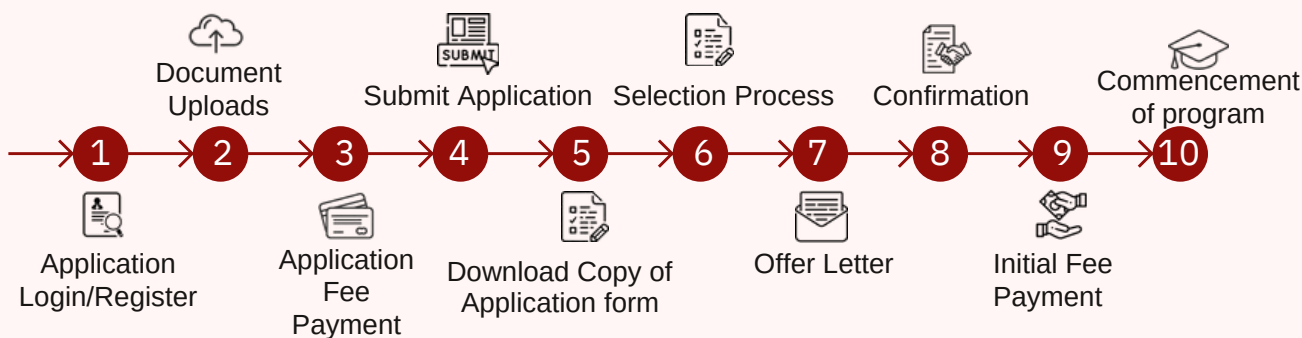
