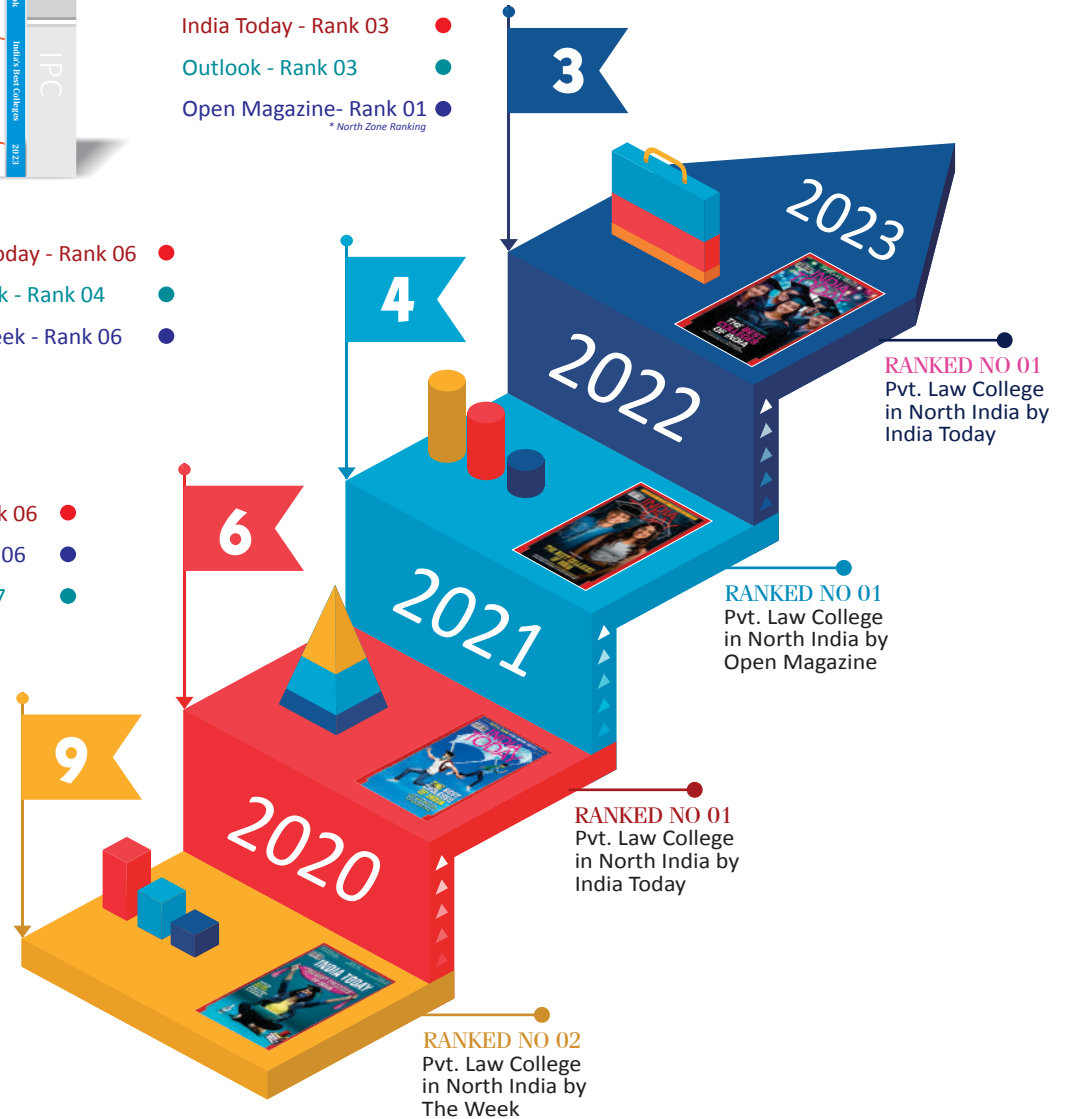

Invitation To Study Law at Lloyd

India is on the threshold of a Development Revolution. Higher education including legal education will determine the quality and direction of the Development Process. With millions of talented youth with higher education entering the job market, nothing can stop the Nation from achieving its development goals sooner than later. As a country committed to rule of law, democracy and human rights, it is the function of legal institutions to organize development in such a manner that the Constitution prescribes. In this process, legal personnel have a significant role to play outside the conventional role of dispute settlement.

Law study, therefore, is not merely a private good but also a public good in which the society has special interest to sustain. There is no other subject so close to life in all its aspects as the subject of law. For the same reason, study of law is a life-long process for which university education is just the beginning.

It is common experience of many of us in the teaching profession that when students join the law school, they are determined to work for justice to weaker sections and wanting to change systems that perpetuate inequality and exploitation in society. It is also our experience that once they complete studies and leave the law school, they tend to lose their idealism and join forces which maintain the same old social order. Of course, there is lot of money one can make in a legal career and there is nothing wrong in advocating the cause of the rich who can pay enough money for legal services.

But if such action results in non-availability or non-affordability of quality legal services to the poor and the marginalized, there is serious risk of the profession getting alienated from the people and justice getting derailed in the process. This is suicidal for the profession as well as for the country and its constitutional values.

A recent report submitted by the Law Commission has recommended several changes to the Advocates Act towards

restructuring the organization and management of the legal profession in India with a view to maintain the nobility and public interest goals of the profession. Furthermore, the profession is today diversified into litigation bar, corporate and in-house lawyers, mediators, arbitrators and trans-national legal practitioners. In emerging areas of legal practice, lawyers are compelled to partner with professionals outside law to provide appropriate services to the clients. With trade in legal services becoming a reality under the WTO, lawyers have to prepare themselves for trans-national legal practice as well which will change the character of the profession as we see it today. In short, those who are entering the practice of law in future may have to adopt new ways of thinking in respect of delivery of services and management of profession.

Study of law prepares one not only to become a legal practitioner. It enables one to take a variety of career options including judiciary, journalism, civil service, politics, teaching and social work. In all these careers, what makes law study relevant is its relation to 'JUSTICE', the eternal quest of every human being. You are welcome to study law and be a justice worker for maximizing justice and fairness in society.

In Lloyd College of Law, you will find plenty of opportunities not just to earn a law degree, but to learn many things about law from outside the classroom and the library. Learning law through experience gives you insights on how law functions in society. Look out for occasions for experiential learning even if you have to forego your vacations to avail of such experiences. Improve your communication skills and your knowledge of contemporary events. 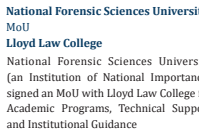

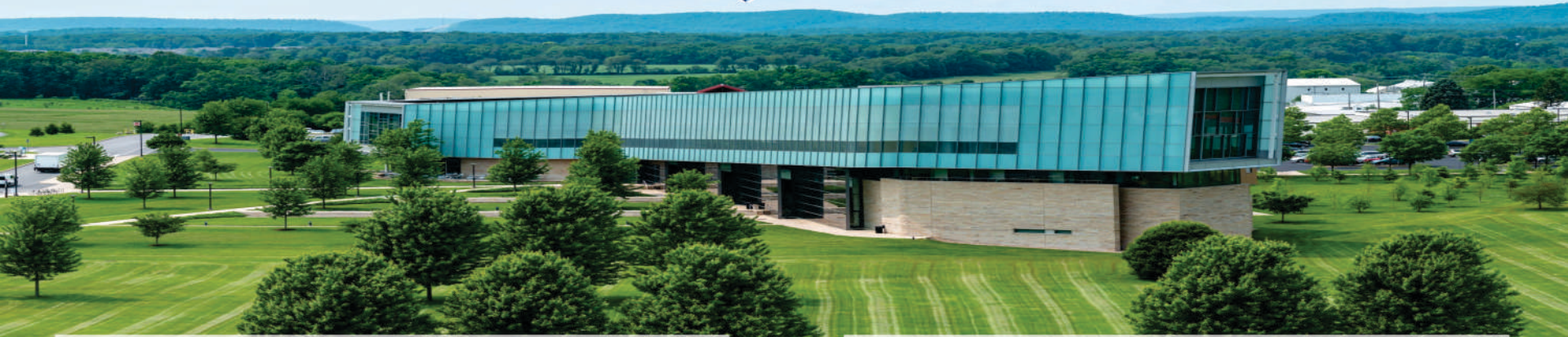

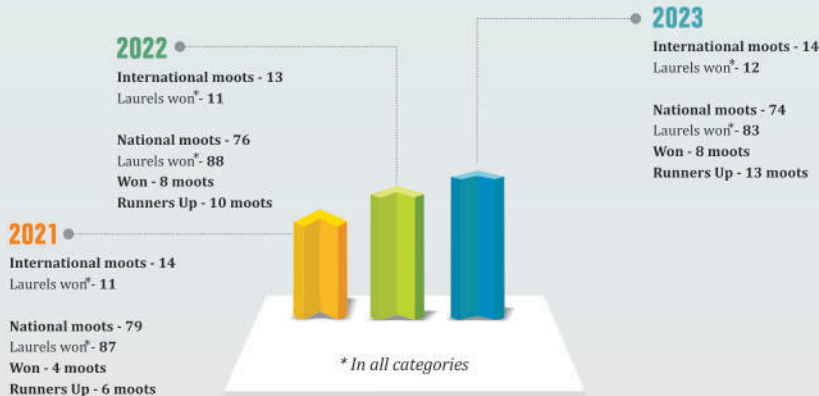

Lloyd Trial Advocacy Competition (LTAC)

Lloyd Trial Advocacy Competition (LTAC) is a year long annual Intra-college training-cum-competition. Selected students are given training on criminal subject matter through 'workshops' that are conducted by experts on relevant stage of a criminal matter. Like, police-officers conduct 'Workshops on Registration of FIR / Collection of Evidences / Preparing Police Report', Public Prosecutors / Advocates conduct 'Workshops on Arguments on Framing of Charge / Prosecution Evidence / Defense Evidence / Final Arguments'.

Workshops are conducted before each stage of the competition. These workshops give the participating students a practical understanding of the criminal matters before they participate in respective stage of the competition. Outcome of the LTAC is that the participants have now understanding of application of criminal procedural law in real-life situations as they have dealt with life-like situation for one whole year in simulating environment. In four editions (2018-19 to 2022-23) of the LTAC, we have trained more than one-hundred students who were ready to deal with any criminal trial matter as soon as they have joined the Bar.

Lloyd Criminal Appeal Advocacy Competition (LCAAC)

Lloyd Criminal Appeal Advocacy Competition (LCAAC) is a six-months long intra-college bi-annual training-cum-competition in which selected students are given training of criminal appeal subject matters by experts from the relevant field. Advocates who have expertise in drafting conduct 'workshops on drafting a criminal appeal', and advocates who have expertise on pleading appellate matters conduct 'workshops on argumenting skills'. The LCAAC is conducted at two stages, (i) Appeal @ High Court Jurisdiction, & (ii) Appeal @ Supreme Court Jurisdiction.

Trial court records (TCRs) of decided matters from Sessions Court in Delhi / Uttar-Pradesh are given to the participating students; they draft their respective appeals on the same, and then plead in their respective matters. Outcome of the LCAAC is that the participants acquire knowledge & understanding on not only on appellate side of litigation, but also of trials as they would read & understand the TCRs running into hundreds of pages. We have successfully completed the 1st edition of the LCAAC in 2022-23, and the 2nd edition was held in June - December, 2023 session.



Corporate Law Practice Centre

Lloyd Corporate Law Practice Centre is an initiative of students to get all the knowledge and practical skills required to make a career in the corporate law practice. The cell was established to facilitate students for practice and profession oriented knowledge, skills, internships and placements. Forty students were selected to attend a month long academic sessions on various courses of corporate laws.

Mr. Lokesh Bulchandani-Associate, delivered sessions on SARFAESI, Insolvency and Bankruptcy Code, Mergers & Acquisitions and Competition law. CLP organized discussion session on Insolvency and Bankruptcy Code. It provided opportunity to participate in Insolvency and Bankruptcy Code Quiz conducted by Institute of Company Secretaries of India.

A group of CLPC is working to file Information in CCI on a very sensitive issue which has repercussion on competition in the market and consumer welfare. CLP organized a session to discuss and research on governmental policy related to corporate world (i.e. Policy for E-commerce Companies by DIPP). Its members are keen to participate in such kind of session and they have submitted various blogs and research paper for CLPC Blog Portal. The members will participate in 'Anti Trust Global Seminar' conducted by American Bar Association. CLP on regular basis organizes sessions like Contract drafting, patent drafting, Client Counseling, workshops, round tables and conferences.

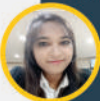

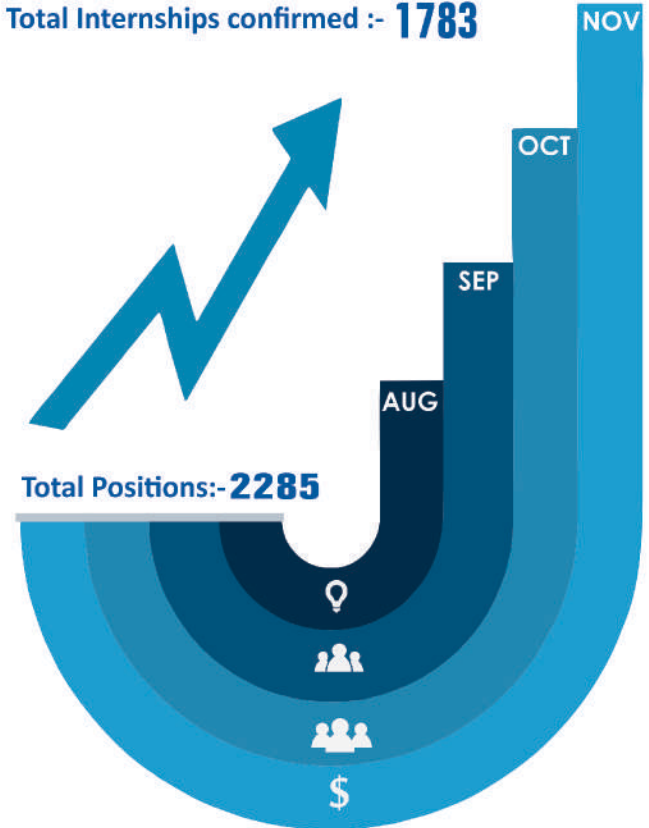

Gender Audit

The college has constituted an Internal Complaints Committee as per the Sexual Harassment of Women at Workplace (Prevention, Prohibition and Redressal) Act 2013. The committee conducts various programs, workshops, counseling for women empowerment and gender sensitization. College is committed to provide a safe campus to female students to achieve ideals of equality enshrined in the Indian Constitution and facilitate their education and learning in the safest, secure and sound environment.

Anti-Ragging Cell and Disciplinary Committee

The college publishes regulations of the UGC and directions given by Hon'ble Courts and Legislature of U.P. in its prospectus and also the college diary which is given to all students at the beginning of every academic year. Ragging is a criminal offence and UGC has notified Regulations on curbing the menace of ragging in educational institutions in order to prohibit, prevent and eliminate the scourge of ragging. The college forms Anti-Ragging Cell and Disciplinary Committee every year.

The names and contact details of the members are notified to the students by publication of their details in the college diary which is presented to every student at the beginning of every academic year. The students in distress owing to ragging related incidents can access the committee at any times. The Anti-Ragging Cell and Disciplinary Committee comprise of both male and female members along with the Deputy Director of the college.

Mandatory Attendance Regulation

Attending classes regularly is mandatory on each student. Attendance as taken in each class daily and is recorded and punched into the software that cannot be changed later. 75% class attendance in regular classes is the minimum criteria for appearing in the University Examination failing which the College will not approve the examination form of the students to the university. No grounds shall be considered to defiate the rule of 75% attendance. The same is in compliance with the attendance rules and criterions of the University Grants Commission (the regulator of the Universities in India), Bar Council of India (the patron of professional legal education in India),
